- Course Selection Process
- Once in the Course Requests area your myDSHA account
- There are two sections
- Available Courses - this is where you will request your courses
- Selected Requests - this section is where your selected courses are listed
- Students must have 16 course selection choices (this includes study hall(s))
- Students already have their Theology, English, Math (unless Freshman Algebra 2 or Honors Algebra 2 are recommended - see below), Science, Social Studies, $1^{\text {st }}$ semester Study Hall, and Applied Wellness classes entered
- Students received their math and science placements, and the math/science courses listed reflect those placements
- If you were approved for either Freshman Algebra 2 or Honors Algebra 2, you will need to choose one of those two courses
- Students required or would like to elect to take the placement tests will be sent an online form to choose which day(s) they would like to take the tests
o Students must select a foreign language, and either a Fine Arts course, Specialized Studies course, or another Study Hall
- Students can find these respective courses by tapping/clicking on those department areas to view courses available to them (located in the "Available Courses" section)
- If interested in an additional study hall $2^{\text {nd }}$ semester, that course is listed in "Miscellaneous" in the Available Courses section
- Courses will indicate whether or not the course is offered $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$, or both semesters
- Students will tap or click on the "Request" button located next to the course to select it
- Foreign Languages are full year courses, students must select the first and second semester options for the language they choose
- Students interested in the second level of any foreign language should sign up for the first level and then take the placement test for that language (any changes will be made afterwards)
- Students opting to not take a foreign language freshman year can elect to take fine arts courses and/or the specialized studies course in place of foreign language
- Please consult the curriculum guide for descriptions of courses
o If you are interested in orchestra or Native Spanish Speakers courses, please let Ms. Wanie know, and we will notify those respective teachers
- Students should tap/click on the "Save" button to complete the process
- Below is an illustration of freshman courses to help aid in what is left to select, and the need for $81^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ semester courses for a total of 16 choices
